- **Food Drive**

We have partnered with Fareway and the Ballard School District to eliminate hunger in this community by having an ongoing food drive bin at the local Fareway store. This food is donated directly to the Ballard Schools to help supplement the Backpack Buddies program and older children who are no longer eligible for Backpack Buddies provisions.

- **Story County Salvation Army**

We volunteer to ring bells for Story County's Red Kettle Campaign. In 2015 496 children from 187 families across Story County received a total of 2,862 toys.
